Initially driven by technical curiosity, Malte has evolved to focus primarily on the creative aspects of design and interpretation. However, he remains deeply connected to the technical side of things, often preferring to be hands-on with the equipment.

After many years of primarily creating visual worlds for theatre, Malte felt a strong desire to return to the concert scene.

The years during and after the COVID-19 pandemic were spent reconnecting with Denmark's music scene, seeking out bands, artists, and performers whose work could benefit from a more storytelling-driven approach to visual design.

Looking ahead to 2025, Malte has a number of exciting projects in the works.
